BACKGROUND

Gonzaga Family Haven is a project of Catholic Charities, in partnership with Gonzaga University, Gonzaga Prep, St. Aloysius Parish, and a host of other groups. The 72 family apartments are permanent housing for families who have experienced homelessness. The Haven will provide resources to help families stabilize their lives. It is located at North Foothills Drive and Nevada Street in the Logan neighborhood.

Many families are graduates of Rising Strong (a Catholic Charities program) or families who qualify for the Homeless Family Coordinated Assessment Program (HFCA). The first 24 families are expected to move in by the beginning of September, the remaining families before or by December.

Families need many items to set up housekeeping and ***we can help***. During June, the Parish Charity and Social Justice Committee is sponsoring a Furniture and Welcome Basket Drive.
